General description:

A splinter. A fragment of faceted glass with a thick, irregular edge. Available in various shapes and sizes. Series of glass tables with irregular, elliptical or round tops.

The purity of glass enhanced by shape. The surface of the top is painted in black or gold. To obtain the irregularities of a glass splinter or the coast of an island, the perimeter is smoothed with a special process that makes each piece unique. The base can be in tubular steel, with four conical legs, or in cone shaped metal for a central pedestal.

Technical description:

Series of tables of different shapes and sizes with glass tops with a faceted perimeter, made with a series of inclined grin-ders to smooth the edge. Two bases available: metal conical pedestal or four metal tubular conical legs, painted in black or gold.
